



## Community Helping Community Meal Sponsorship

Red Hook Responds, in conjunction with Red Hook Eats, is a volunteer based group providing meals for the homebound, ill and elderly during this time of COVID19. The meals are made possible thanks to donations from our generous community members. On average, we deliver between 60-90 dinner meals a day. Delivery is available 7 days a week.

### **How does an individual or local business sponsor a day of meals?**

First, you would choose a local restaurant in Red Hook to sponsor. Then, as a sponsor, you would make a donation of \$12 to \$15 per meal to that restaurant (the exact specifics would be between the sponsor and the restaurant). Next, the restaurant will be assigned a date to prepare between 80 to 100 meals to be used to feed our local requesters. Finally, these meals are delivered to community members in need by our RHR drivers. RHR members are available to coordinate and help with this process.

### **How does this help Red Hook Responds?**

By sponsoring a night of meals, Red Hook Responds helpline and delivery system is supported by not having to pay for food supplies that day. The help requester who is in need, is directly fed by the sponsor. This means, we are able to continue this service even longer, making a continued difference in the lives of community members.
